Mike--

First..recalling a moment...

On December 11, 2008, at the open house in Renaissance Center, right after the meeting, you and I and Farr Miller, and I believe Bob Davis and possibly one or two additional others were speaking outside the door, in the hallway. I don't recall exactly who, as we were introducing ourselves, and it was the first time we had met, when Mr. Jim Pfof walked up and put his hand on my shoulder and addressed me as "my friend...", I responded sharply that he was not my friend, and the conversation between him and I moved onto his misrepresentation of me and others and the neighborhood vote that I had never received the opportunity to participate in. I recall **Mr. Pfof clearly saying that he did not send me a vote because it was sent only to homesteaded properties, and I was an absentee landlord, not entitled to vote.**

Some questions of you, regarding this moment....

Do you clearly recall it?

Do you clearly recall who was present at that moment who might have heard Mr. Pfof make his statement to me about the voting?

If yes, could you put in writing, what it was that you heard him say?

Do you think the other participants present who might have heard him would recall that moment and what he said, or was it something that only I would recall, as it was only of impact to myself...your opinion?

What I'm after at this point is a clear statement of what he said, and signatures attesting to it. I believe this will be very important, and wish to document it as solidly as possible, short of a court deposition, and want to reply to the statement letter made by Wayne Tedder to the City Commission with a copy of a jointly signed statement, even at this late date. With that public statement made by Jim Pfof, he certified that his vote was effectively null and void, as it left out all non-resident property owners, who comprise 1/3 of the neighborhood. I do not want this statement of his lost.

What can you add to the recollection and any other similar statements he has made at any time that can be documented?

I sincerely appreciate any time you can put towards documenting this moment. Thank you.
